Woods used for Le Fay basses

Wood for solid bodies	Ash / Figured ash / Alder / Whitewood / Figured maple / Curly maple / Figured cherry
Wood for sandwich constructions	Figured maple / Figured walnut / Curly maple / Ice birch / Wenge / Figured cherry / „Crazy cherry“ (A crazy sort of cherrywood, extremely rare, very hard and heavy) / Pyramide ash (extremely rare, very beautiful, estimated age at least 100 years). For the rear side we normally use Ash , Mahogany , or American cherry .
Wood for necks	Padouk or Hard maple
Wood for fingerboards	Padouk / Hard maple / Rosewood / Ebony
