Topdots mother of pearl and 3mm sidedots, with a luminous core

Finish: Acrylic closed-pore satin finish, stained in "Singer Gold"

Bridge: Le Fay

Pick-ups: 4 single-coils in 2 groups, by Le Fay

Cockpit: 2 miniswiches:

Rear active/passive, front both pickup groups humbucker/single coil

5 Knobs:

Active bass and treble - boost only, passive treble cut always on

and optionally

2x volume or master volume and pan

or master volume and 4/6-way pick-up selector

Wood for solid bodies Click for Pictures	Ash / Figured ash / Alder / Whitewood / Figured maple / Curly maple / Figured cherry	
Wood for sandwich constructions Click for Pictures	Figured maple / Figured walnut / Curly maple / Ice birch / Wenge / Figured cherry / "Crazy cherry" (A crazy sort of cherrywood, extremely rare, very hard and heavy) / Pyramide ash (extremely rare, very beautyful, estimated age at least 100 years). For the rear side we normally use Ash, Mahogany, or American cherry.
